IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- ♦ **CAUTION:** Luminaires and their auxiliary equipment may pose a risk of fire or damage to property if not installed or maintained correctly.
- ♦ Must be installed to the latest electrical safety regulations by a qualified electrician.
- ♦ Class I products must be earthed
- ♦ Maximum input voltage 240V AC 50HZ
- ♦ Ensure all electrical connections are tight with no loose strands, including factory made connections.
- ♦ All luminaires run hot. It is the installers responsibility to consider fire risk and take appropriate precautions.
- ♦ Always switch off mains supply before fitting, servicing, changing the lamp or moving position of the luminaire.
- ♦ Replace failed lamps immediately. Allow the lamp and fitting to cool before replacing.
- ♦ Ensure correct lamp wattage is used, refer to product label.
- ♦ IP54: Caulk to building face to achieve IP54 rating
- ♦ This fitting runs **HOT**, consider location prior to insulation.

INSTALLATION

- ♦ Determine appropriate location for fitting.
- ♦ Ensure Mains supply is turned off.
- ♦ Remove mounting base from fitting.
- ♦ Allow supply leads from wall or ceiling to penetrate the rubber ring in mounting base, Fix mounting base to desired location.
- ♦ Connect supply leads to appropriate connections: Brown or Red (L), Blue or Black (N) and Green/Yellow (Earth) (NB. These luminaires must be earthed)
- ♦ Ensure there are no exposed conductors, loose strands or trapped insulation.
- ♦ Fix body of fitting onto mounting base
- ♦ Install lamp (must not exceed wattage specified by product label).
- ♦ It is recommended to consult an electrician before switching on power.

GUARANTEE

- ♦ HUGO provides warranty for 1 year for these fittings, against defects in the material and/or workmanship. This period commences from the date of delivery and is only valid if the fitting is installed in accordance to the instructions provided and to local regulations. If defective material or workmanship is found within the warranty period, it must be returned to the supplier with details and proof of the original delivery and purchase dates. Any additional costs including labour must be submitted in writing and approved by HUGO prior to remedial work being initiated.
- ♦ Warranty becomes null and void if components have been tampered, altered or modified in any way. Damage to fittings by fire, water or similar will revoke the warranty.
- ♦ HUGO reserves the right to improve, modify or update the designs without prior notice.
